1. Cauquira (main district)
  - With more than 5 congregations
  - A pastor with experience is needed for these congregations
  - Bible worker placed by 3AM 04/01/26
2. Puerto Lempira (biggest Community in the whole Miskito región)
3. Ahuas
  - Bible Worker placed 01/01/26
4. Palacios
  - Bible Worker placed 01/01/26
5. Brus Laguna
  - Is the second largest community but **without a single Adventist member.**
  - Bible Worker placed 01/01/26

Yearly Expense of 14 months in Honduras = \$43,400

FYI—A Rough 12 hour drive from La Ceiba to Palacios is expected if driving. 4x4 required!





# God's Precious People in Palacios

---

- They are eager to build a place of worship and have dedicated land which was donated to their future house of worship. 15.94875° N, 84.94637° W
- Builders and Materials are needed still. (\$75,000 estimate)
- Possibility of empowering someone with a shallow water boat to transport materials and workers to job site. (\$10,000 est)

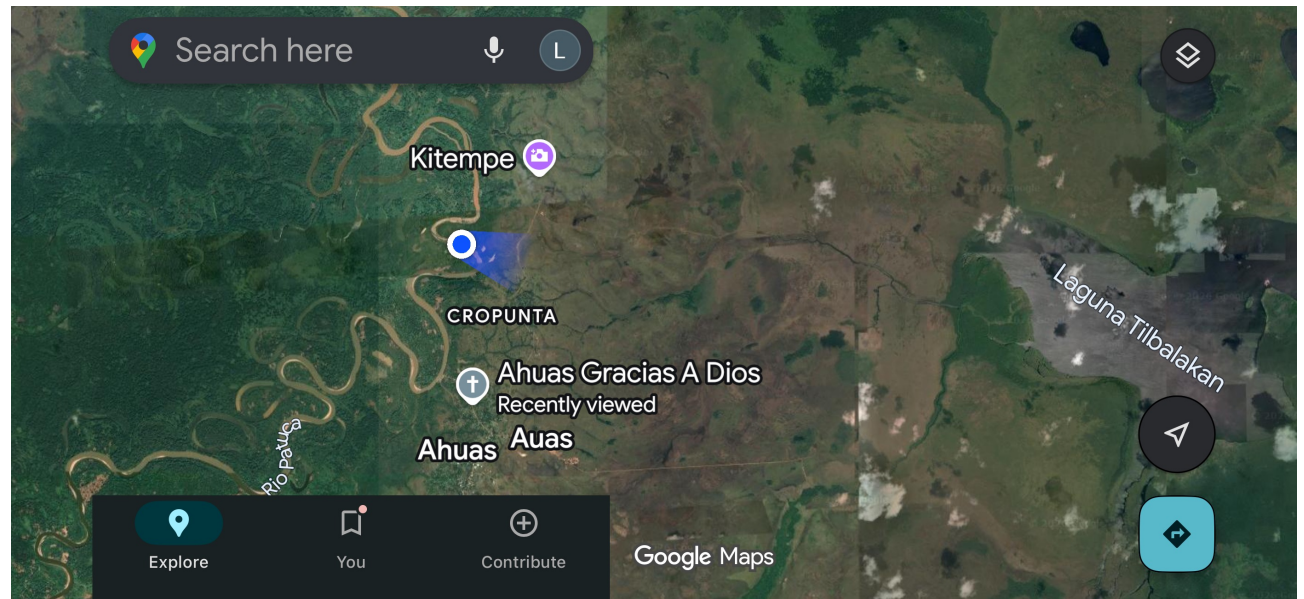

## Counting the Cost

- Transportation cost is the number one high burden for everyone in this Operation and this region.
- Although our liaison to this Op was clear that this is the major hurdle to be overcome, it wasn't until the February 17-25, 2026 reconnaissance mission that I truly appreciated his counsel.
- Mark my word, It is very **expensive and grueling** to travel in this región.



Almost 24 Hours of travel in just 3 days.  
No time to eat or sleep if we were to get actionable intel—which we did.



Don't worry. We won't push you to the same extremes if you join us on our next adventure mission trip here—unless you want the full experience!

However, we did rest some on Sabbath after preaching and teaching in Puerto Lempira.

- We got to meet with God's precious people here too and even had a K9 who was an honorary deacon there that came in and out during the worship service. We were told he was there every week and he wanted in the photo. So, I named him "Sabado". All the members liked his new name and got a good laugh out of it too.



# Miskito Coast Considerations

---

- ✓ We don't have a single Miskito Pastor in the whole country
- ✓ 3AM is willing to sponsor a Miskito student along with the Honduran Union at UNADECA (Adventist University in Costa Rica) to be "Rightly Trained" and then hire such person in our field after completing their degree.
- ✓ Meanwhile, as a key part of this Operation, 3AM will support 5 Bible workers with motorcycles to serve in their assigned locations on a one year trial where our goal is to get God's people self sufficient there after.

## Final Observation For Self Sufficiency

- We noticed everything was imported to the 5 locations we are posted.
- Suggested 3AM empower God's people with a Dairy Cow and calf for milk, goats for cheese, chickens for eggs and bees for honey production whereby all of these can not only supply the salary for the farm worker, it will also bless the community with lower priced goods and help pay the Bible worker and/or Pastor's salaries. (\$5,000)
- A well with a water treatment plant in two locations was also advised due to import costs. It too could help provide salaries while blessing the community. (\$20,000)



# Duty

# Update Q1 2026 effective immediately

---

- 5 Bible workers have been sponsored by 3AM (\$600+ monthly each)
- Remote Areas these are stationed are: Palacios, Cauquira, Brus Laguna & Ahuas
- 5 motorcycles authorized, purchased and shipped.
- 5 Cell phones purchased to allow training and oversight.
- Currently Godpods aka MP3s are being developed to be distributed around this interior. At least 11 (\$40 each) are needed for 11 communities.
- 3AM aims to replicate in the jungles of Honduras what we are doing in Uganda--from food, to literacy programs to training folks with various useful skills—Our goal is to Empower God’s People!

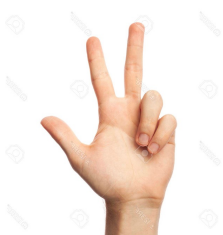

## What is Needed?

- We need a dedicated person skilled in setting up the bee hives at 3 locations
- We need a dedicated person skilled with dairy livestock to help set up at 1 location
- We need a person skilled in making goat cheese at 2 locations
- We need a person skilled to help us establish a water purification plant in 2 locations.
- We need lots of prayers and generous donors to help us accomplish the goal of reaching 120,000 people on the Miskito Coast.
